# Report on the workshop entitled "Exploring a workflow for architecture design studio utilizing digital tools."

I conducted a workshop at Piloo Mody College of Architecture from the 5<sup>th of</sup> February to the 7<sup>th</sup> February of 2024. This workshop was participated by second year students at the college.

The goal of this workshop was to explore a design studio workflow which utilized computer aided modeling and graphic design software. This 3-day workshop introduced and familiarized the participants with software namely AutoCAD, SketchUp, and Photoshop. Exercises were introduced to constitute the workflow and past projects which were attempted manually (by hand) were attempted using these digital tools.

### What I expected from the workshop

While pursuing my doctorate at Texas A&M University, I was also serving as an instructor for first year students for several terms. As a part of my job, I introduced software to the students in their first term. At the end of the term, students developed familiarity with the digital tools and produced exemplary work which would eventually enable them to apply for internships. I hoped I could achieve similar output from the students of Piloo Mody college in India. Before the start of the workshop, I expected the software tools techniques which I introduced would be new knowledge for the students. I hoped I could provide students with a foundation for advancing their digital modeling and graphic design skills.

### What actually happened at the workshop

The students who attended the event were sincere and hardworking. The students understood my instructions and responded well to my lectures. They had the necessary hardware and software required for the event. Although Photoshop was new for the students, they were already familiar with AutoCAD and Sketchup. So, the workshop served to refamiliarize them with the software. The students had earlier attempted their previous term's studio project (residence) using AutoCAD and Sketchup.

On the first day of the workshop, I introduced the basics of Photoshop which was new to them. I talked about the interface, the tools, the settings for the tools, creating a new document and other features. I demonstrated to the students the tools used to edit and enhance graphics. I

also demonstrated blending multiple images using the software such as floorplans and elevations with a photorealistic background.

The second day was devoted to introducing AutoCAD and SketchUp. For AutoCAD, my priority was to ensure consistency and quality of their AutoCAD building drawings as the students had used AutoCAD previously. I provided an AutoCAD metric template, and I emphasized the purpose of layers and its attributes and asked the students to assign the appropriate layers for their work. Layers were created for the different building components and colors, line weight, and line type were assigned for the different layers. For Sketchup, I refamiliarized the students with the tools and features. I also demonstrated how to create freeform curvilinear shapes.

On the third and final day, we explored more features of Sketchup. I asked the students to create an isometric view of their residence and use Photoshop to organize their work created in the three days. A sample of their work is shown on Table 1.




Table 1 A sample of the work produced by the students.

The students' prior knowledge of AutoCAD and Sketchup definitely helped for my workshop, and I could cover new topics as well. Towards the end, I mentioned the relevance and potential of Artificial Intelligence in our industry. I demonstrated the function of an Artificial Intelligence extension of Sketchup called Diffusion which can generate photorealistic renderings of simple Sketchup models within seconds.

### Final thoughts

The opportunity of undertaking the workshop was a rewarding, productive, and enlightening experience for me. In my opinion, there is not much difference between the American and Indian students (I have worked with) in their capability in understanding and applying the concepts learned for digital modeling. The students seemed excited for the potential of the tools covered, which was heartening for me. I thank Priyanka Kedia ma'am for her support during the workshop. I also thank the principal, Dharitri Das

ma'am, for inviting me for the wonderful experience of conducting a workshop at the fine institution.






