- 3. AD, please prepare PPT for critical analysis of architectural works, snaps from good books, examples to INSPIRE us, show us, have discussion (to discuss us what to do and what not to) like Swayam sir(in landscape architecture) and Anshuman sir(in basic design 1&2, landscape architecture). I (and our class) have loved those classes and them.
- 4. AD, please DON'T change brief multiple times. Evaluate the brief properly before assigning. Also fix certain things which are to be fixed like column size, no. of services and their related things and other hard and fast stuff...wayyy early in design rather than changing it multiple times.
- 5. Prepare a structure and divide the work among faculty (Debasmita ma'am was great in doing this for our 4th sem AD by being realistic, logical and dedicated)— we hardly had any complaints.
- 6. Keep a CHECKLIST of what to criticize in design when students are showing their works (a lot of mistakes are ignored and are acknowledged wayyy later-very troublesome)
- 7. For creative subjects like DC, look out for creators (real life experts on YouTube, Instagram)–how they teach, how they breakdown things to make it understandable, captivating and INSPIRING and worth the time! BTW the ppt on logo design was nice!
- 8. DC, Assigning a group project with 15 members was not a good idea at all especially for our class where 15 person attendance is a rarity! I wanted to say this but the heat at the moment was a lot. A lot of time was wasted. Yes, I learned people skills (via a lot of chaos and drama) (ps. I'm talking about the temple group) but some more things were way more important (& fruitful & interesting) to learn in this subject which I didn't get to learn.
- 9. I know teachers think we're not worth of having these changes and passionate teaching (because they don't get the same passion and response in return from us. I sympathise it and I'm sorry). For a subject with 2 credits, giving 6 spaces to design and that also for a hotel is not justified. Where one of the main faculty remained absent for half of the sem or she would come after 1:30 pm and give priority to certain students only is very much unfair to me. And again for a subject with 2 credits we have done more than 50 - 60 printouts considering the final portfolio itself was of 30 pages of A3 sheets in colour. Our teachers didn't consider any extensions and when there was an unexpected holiday in the middle of a submission ,our faculty told us that she would deduct 10 points since nobody submitted....whereas she was aware that we were giving our 2nd internal exams at that time. This resulted on bad design, no motivation to work,and also unable to focus on other subjects because of this.... we needed to make more than 6 models for interior design which we have never done for AD itself....and on asking for certain doubts it is being told to us that they cannot teach us so much since the semester is short ... if we are to consider their inability to part us knowledge, why do the faculty never consider our part?

The workload was substantial in comparison to the other segments. While I gained valuable knowledge, the amount of work could have been more aligned with the subject's credit weight.

The semester was short and crisp, I learnt a lot but the only major issues was the quantity of deliverables put forth for different sections, the duration was same for everyone but the amount of work assigned differed with a greater margin, this resulted in extreme pressure. The conflict among the teachers led to a lack of clarity in understanding the main concept. I don't have a problem with the workload itself, as it taught me valuable lessons. The learning could have been in a fair and consistent manner. Our goal is to learn, not to compete in a work race. It's about focusing on the quality of learning, not just the amount of work we do.

The major issue was the deliverables put forth for different sections, the duration of the semester was same for everyone but the deliverables differed with a huge margin, also the constant comparison with other sections irrespective of the work load caused a great sense of pressure and demotivation, the number of sheets and amount of work differed immensely. I am here for the fair and equal learning process without the fear of being constantly compared to any of my batchmates on the basis of quantity rather than quality.

Instances arose where individuals lacking proficiency were subjected to ridicule, without being guided towards the correct understanding. Regrettably, the prescribed submission deadlines lacked flexibility, instilling a sense of trepidation towards the course. This apprehension became pronounced to the extent that I refrained from attending certain sessions. Throughout the course, an overarching emphasis on quantity took precedence over the appreciation of quality. This approach tended to undermine the inherent value of meticulous craftsmanship and attention to detail. As a result, the learning

experience became disproportionately oriented towards output volume rather than the cultivation of refined skills and refined outcomes. The faculty, while undoubtedly possessing prowess in architectural practice, presented limitations as effective educators. The divergence between expertise in the field and pedagogical proficiency manifested in a manner that impeded the overall learning process. The critical role of teaching extends beyond mere subject knowledge, encompassing the ability to effectively impart that knowledge, nurture understanding, and provide supportive guidance. In summation, while acknowledging my personal limitations in working drawings, it is evident that systemic issues within the instructional approach adversely impacted the learning experience. A pronounced focus on quantity, coupled with the absence of comprehensive guidance for those seeking to enhance their proficiency, created an environment that undermined the true potential for growth and development within the realm of working drawings.



The semester was completed in rush & in these short semester circumstances plan finalization was taken a lot of time



We got notes from the other section which turns out to be notes of Sonika maam basically. So again we had to study ourselves. For first internal we made two sheets since few people didnt submit we also suffered and wrote an online exam and submitted in google classroom. The next day they wanted the hardcopy too, i didnt have it so i told that ive submitted ill bring it the next day but they sent me home during class hours to bring and submit otherwise they wont mark me. This is shear harassment. The one who are doing the most are being targetted more. This semester has taken a serious toll on both my mental and physical health. It has been the same for my close peers. So its a request to be more considerate and generous regarding the well being of the students as a whole.
