


### c) Academics:

The college offers a five year B.Arch program, a two-year M.Arch program in Habitat Design and is also a Coursework centre for students pursuing Ph.D in Architecture under the BPUT, Rourkela

### Details of Academic Programs:

The B.Arch program has an intake of 120. The M.Arch(Habitat Design) program has an intake of 20. Admissions to both the programs are as per Council of Architecture and State OJEE norms.

## **Academic Delivery planning and implementation:**

PMCA has a well-planned curriculum planning and delivery system for effective delivery of the courses offered to students.

An Academic Calendar of the institute is prepared at the beginning of each academic session in consonance with the Academic Calendar of the University. The Academic Calendar of the institute is the guide for effective delivery of the curriculum and helps in administering the teaching-learning plan. PMCA adheres to its Academic Calendar for meeting the requirements of the university in general and achieving its targeted academic standards in particular.

Lesson plans are prepared by respective faculty of the assigned courses adhering to the Course Objectives and Outcomes. Rigorous discussions on course work delivery comprising teaching methods, practical adaptability of the subject, horizontal linkage, guidelines for assignments and its learning outcomes, guest lectures for enrichment of the subjects, etc are finalized before the commencement of classes.

Academic Coordinators of respective batches (along with Principal, Academic Head) conduct Orientation for each batch at the beginning of every academic session. Each Academic session is planned comprehensively, linking the subjects both horizontally and vertically for fostering critical thinking and giving a better teaching-learning experience to the students.

The entire curriculum delivery and implementation is monitored regularly by the Academic Coordinators of each batch and discussed with the Academic Head and the Principal, who together constitute the Academic Monitoring Committee, as per a planned schedule. The Academic Monitoring Committee of the institute regularly monitors and assesses the course delivery, other enrichment programs planned and helps to sort out the issues (if any) timely, thereby, ensuring the adherence to the Academic Calendar.

The Examination section of the institute prepares an Exam calendar for Conduct of internal as well as end semester assessments in line with the University Academic Calendar. PMCA has a rigorously structured CIE in place to monitor and analyse the

students' academic progress. This monitoring is carried out continuously through quizzes, end module tests, and assignments by the Subject teachers at their own level and through two internal tests (as scheduled in the Academic Calendar of the institute).

The Examination section of PMCA prepares its own calendar and periodically takes out notices for question paper preparation, conduct and evaluation of internal tests to meet the deadlines of the university. Sessional/practical subjects carry 100 marks that are distributed judiciously over regular progress of work, intermittent assessment, and final viva voce at the end of the course.

Final year thesis/dissertation of students is assessed through panel vivas at various stages of their dissertation.

These checks and balances keep the students on their toes and prevent laxity in the overall learning process.

Barrier free environment in the campus includes:

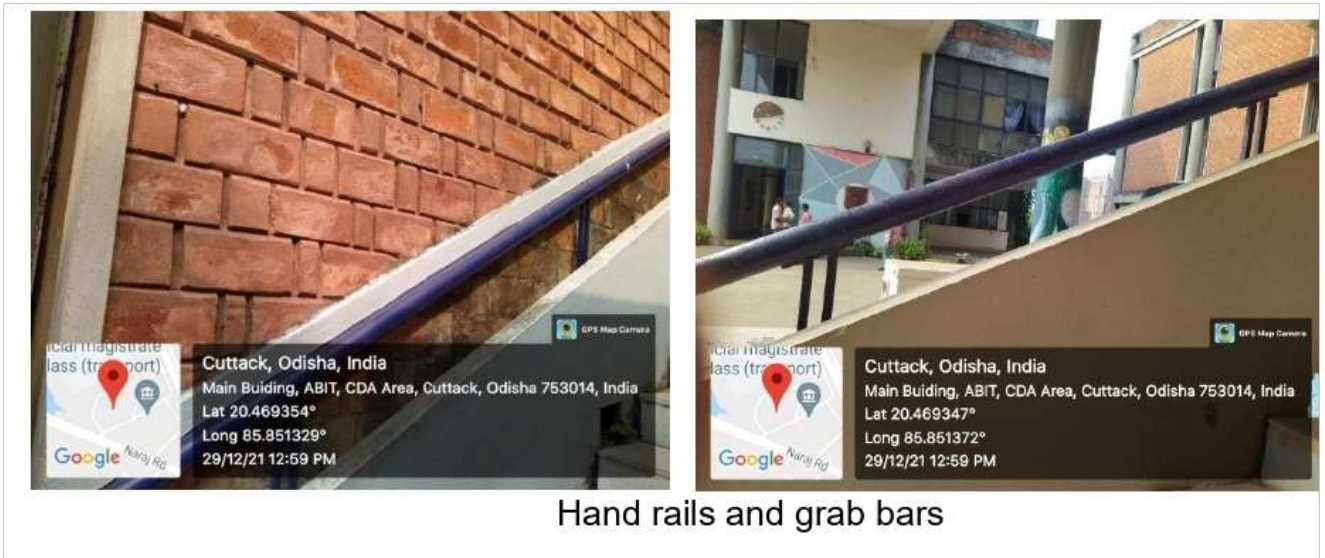
- Availability of barrier free toilet in the Ground Floor of Academic Block with hand rails and grab bar provision.
- For wheelchair accessibility, there is a provision of ramp at the entrance of the college which has a non-slippery surface.
- Tactile pathways and adequate lighting has been provided in the campus.
- Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, easily accessible soft copies of reading materials, screen reading facilities are available and provided on demand.
- Careful design of steps and stairs has been done with proper provision of hand rails and proper lighting for the safety of all.
- Wall mounted signs such as room no, class room, library, public utilities etc. are placed at heights of 1.30m – 1.60m from floor finish as per Barrier Free requirements.
- Kerbs and slopes instead of steps have been provided at strategic places.
- Open doorways to aid in seamless movement have been adopted in the design .

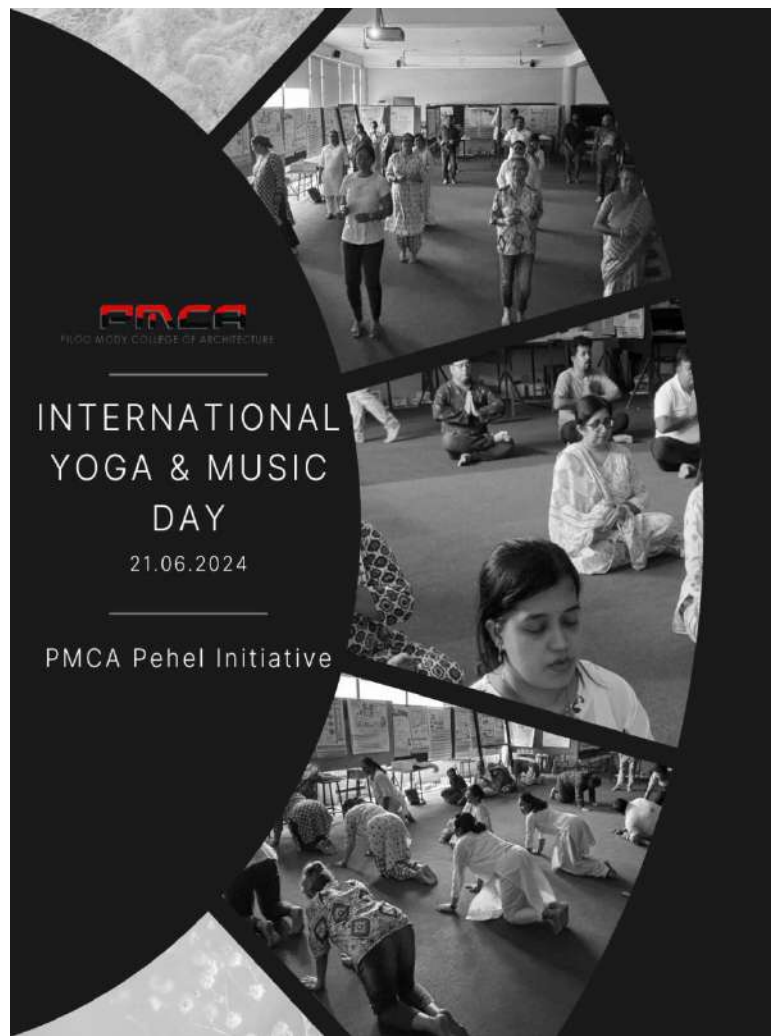
